NOTES:

1. Meet with your academic advisor to have your Advising Hold released prior to registration.
2. Fifteen credit hours per semester. Students may transfer to the Bachelor of Architecture degree a maximum of 6 credit hours (9 if BEDA from NCSU) of previous pre-professional coursework provided they were **not** necessary for your pre-professional degree and if you have the appropriate approval. You must declare your intention to transfer these credits no later than the first week of the Fall semester. Submit your completed "**Course Transfer Request Form**" to the person signing this Advising Report. Contact your advisor if you have questions.
3. If you must complete any of these prerequisites see your advisor. They **may** have to be taken in excess of the 30 credits hours.
4. If you have already taken this course (or an equivalent course) **or** if you have **completed** IDP, you may substitute an architecture elective. ARC 561 will be available **both** semesters.
5. ARC 414, ARC 432, and ARC 441 must be completed before graduation (please note the semester in which they are offered). If they or an equivalent have already been completed, then you may substitute an elective course in order to meet the 30 required credit hours. The curriculum requires that all elective courses for the B. Arch. degree be ARC courses or be taught by an architecture faculty member. Further, a **maximum** of 9 credit hours of 400 level courses may be applied to the B. Arch. degree requirement; the remainder must be 500 level courses.
6. **FALL AND SPRING SEMESTER ELECTIVES:** Check at the School of Architecture for available courses.
7. **A minimum grade of C- is required in each course to obtain credit toward graduation. A cumulative graduate point average of 2.0 must be maintained to satisfy requirements for the degree of Bachelor of Architecture.** All courses taken by the student after admission to the professional program will count toward his or her overall grade point average of courses taken during the fifth year even though an individual course may not be part of the student's degree program.
8. Work completed more than six years prior to the date on which the professional degree is granted may not be used as credit toward to B.Arch. degree unless approved by the Director of Architecture.
9. A maximum of 3 credit hours of Independent Study will be allowed.
