

Mobile Workshop: The Raleigh Strollway September 15, 2022 <u>Tour # 1</u>: 12:30 PM to 2 PM; <u>Tour # 2</u>: 2:30 PM to 4 PM



The Raleigh Strollway is envisioned as a non-motorized transportation and cultural greenway corridor connecting Chavis Park to Dix Park. Participate in a walking tour of two alternate routes that are under consideration for the Strollway and learn about the complex challenges and tremendous opportunities to link elements of downtown Raleigh together with this innovative concept.

The City of Raleigh envisions the strollway as a designated path through infrastructure that already exists, but feature new amenities, better signage, road treatments and other additions to improve the experience. The path would make transit — like using bikes and scooters — safer for citizens. The curent planned route is 1.3 miles and runs from Lenoir to South Saunders
