Schedule for Full-Time Students Revised Fall 2024 Bachelor's of Art + Design at NCSU

This is a guide for prospective students interested in transferring into the NC State College of Design - Art + Design program from a NC Community College - Associates in Arts (AA) program. The Bachelor's of Art + Design requires 8 semesters of studio AFTER transfer which typically takes 4 years of enrollment at NC State, regardless of the number of transfer credits or completion of an associate's degree. Recommendations for Competitive Applicants:

NC State Undergraduate Admissions employs a holistic approach in reviewing transfer students' applications and considers a range of accomplishments and qualifications. Recommended courses listed above, and GPA recommendations, are departmental recommendations and are not minimum requirements for transfer admissions.

Recommendations:

- 2.7 or higher cumulative GPA
- English Composition
- College-level pre-calculus or higher math course

College of Design Admissions Requirements

- Fall entry only, requires an online portfolio and creative essay with the deadline of November 1st
- Completion of a 10-piece portfolio and design essay (250 300 words).
 - Evidence of Creativity: Pieces that show innovation and imagination.
 - o 2D and 3D Skills: Sketching, Drawing, and/or Sculpturing within a variety of mediums and sizes.
 - Digital Media: Creating within a digital medium including digital graphics, animation, videography, and/or entry-level programming samples.

Department of Media Arts, Design, and Technology - Program Notes

- Course Catalog for the Art + Design program.
- A grade of C- or higher is required.
- Students will work with their Faculty Advisor to choose a focus area in Animation, Gaming & Interaction Design or Fibers & Soft Construction. Design Studio courses will pertain to the students' chosen concentration.
- International Experience (6 credit hours) is required. This may be a Design Studio worth 6 credit hours (when available), or two 3-credit-hour advised electives.
- No more than one (1) six credit studio may be taken in any given semester.
